# Technical Details of the Survey, TNM April 2022

- Coverage: Philippines
  - National Capital Region (NCR)
  - Balanced Luzon
  - Visayas
  - Mindanao
- Duration: April 2-6, 2022
- Respondents and Sample Size:
  - One thousand two hundred (1200) male and female probability respondents aged 18 years and above who are registered and likely voters from Class AB, C, D or E homes were interviewed for the study.
- Sampling Design:
  - Random sampling for selecting the sample barangays.
  - The number of barangays selected for each city/municipality was proportional to its corresponding population size.
  - In each sample barangay, interval sampling was used to draw 5 sample households, following a random start. In each household, a probability respondent was chosen using a probability selection table (Kish Grid).
  - Margin of Error:  $\pm 3\%$

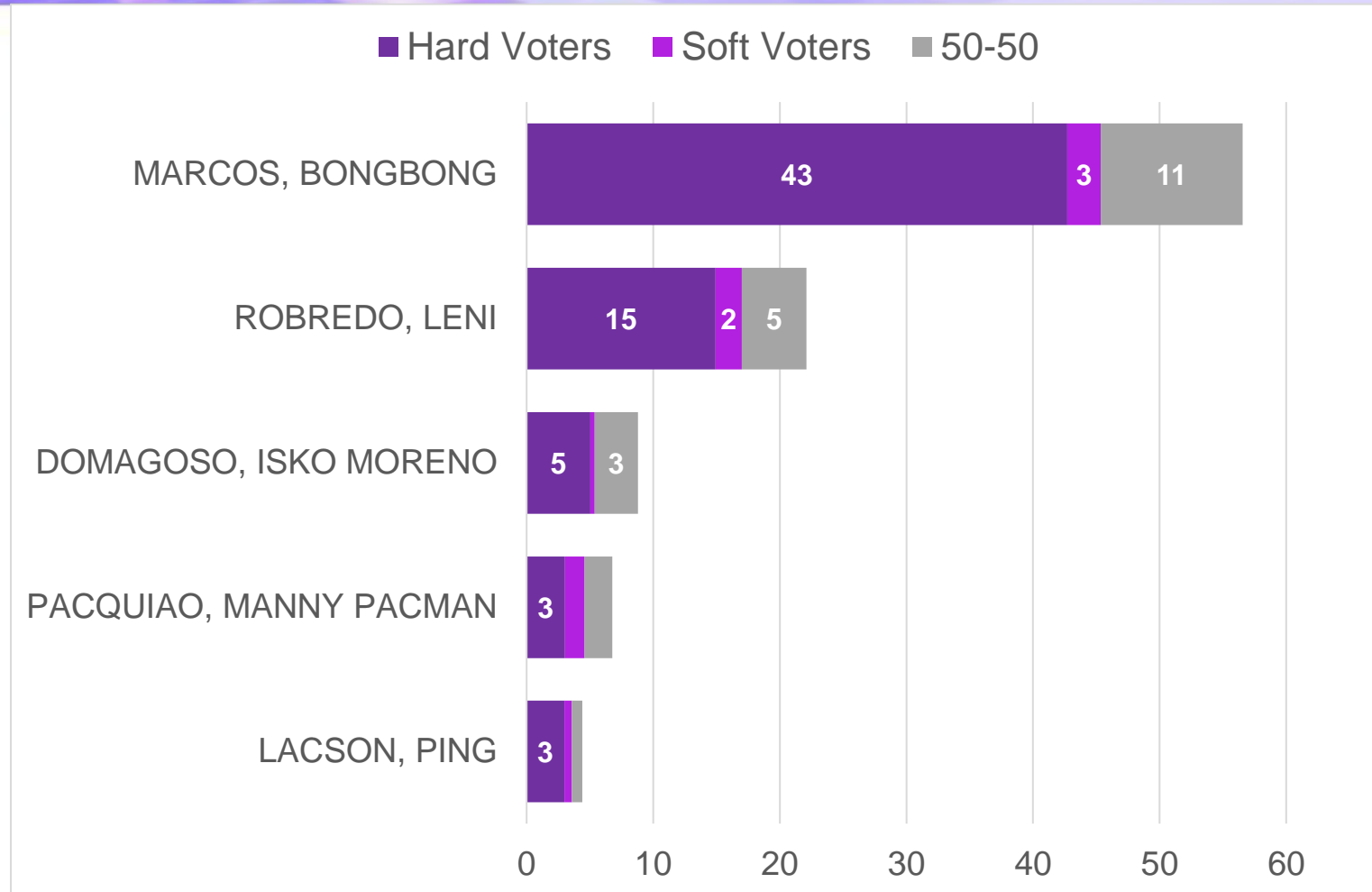

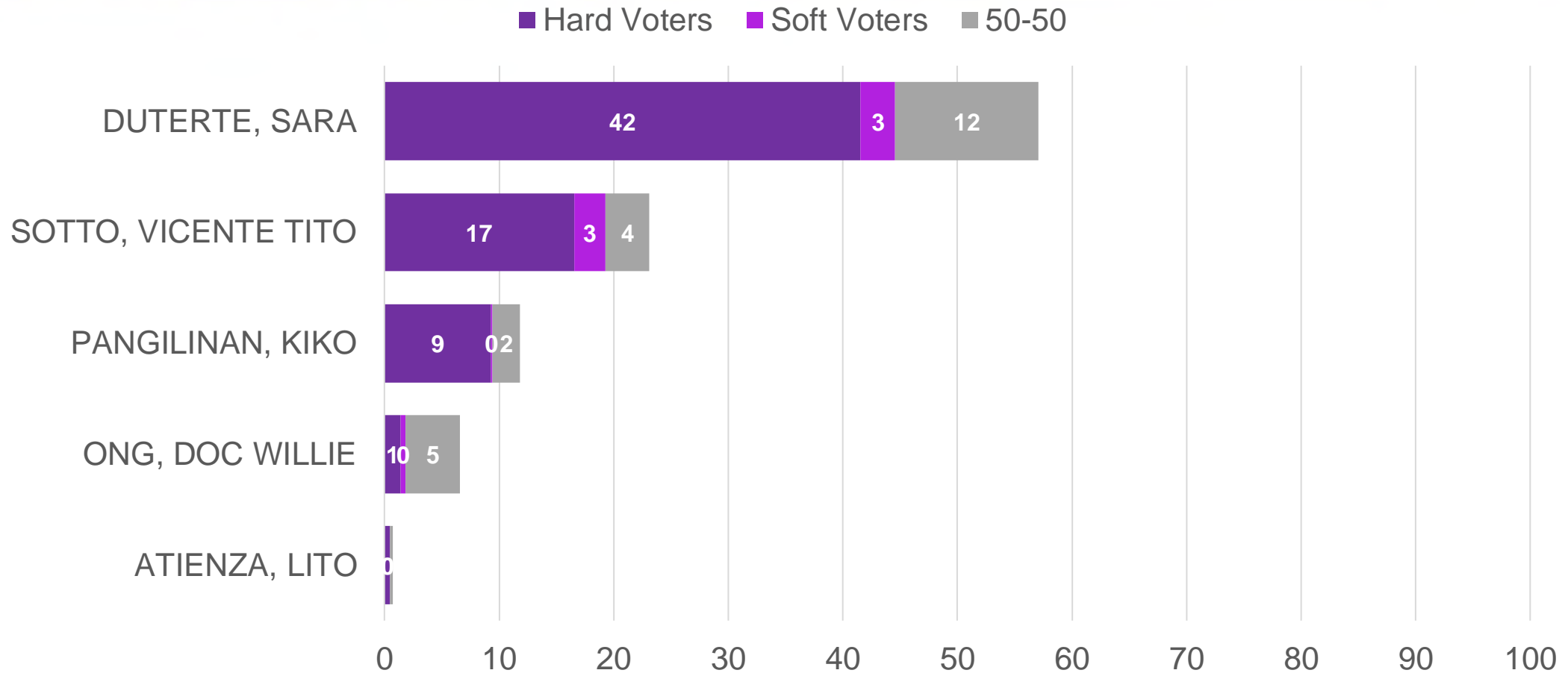


Figure 6. Likelihood of Changing Votes by Candidate and by Voter's Behavior, Base: Likely Voters, 89.3%
